Re: 2008 report for the *Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act* originally known as the *Campus Security Act*

Federal regulations require that all schools of higher education disclose campus security and crime information on an annual basis.

The 2008 *Campus Crime and Security Survey* for *The Restaurant School at Walnut Hill College* confirms that there were zero criminal offenses in classroom buildings, residence buildings and on public property immediately surrounding the campus.

The Restaurant School at Walnut Hill College has a comprehensive program regarding campus safety and security. The program includes training, designated safety and security staff, closed circuit recording systems, computerized reporting and the full college community involvement in order to ensure and enhance our students' safe enjoyment of the college campus. We also cooperate with all colleges located in the University City area.
